



A free CPD industry conference is being held at London's Institute of Directors on Wednesday 11 June and will showcase new European air source heat pump technology in the UK for the first time.

Ashley Bateson, Head of ACEs sustainability steering group has again agreed to chair the conference. He last year commented that 'all parties need to be involved in all stages of the build to ensure a soft landings.'
