MKTS prides itself on only using quality materials in the manufacture of its products and with years of experience in the industry behind it, and friendly and helpful staff, customers know they are receiving a timber frame designed and manufactured under strict supervision, to ensure exact requirements are met and the end result is a home built to the highest specification.

The recent huge increase in awareness of environmental issues is nowhere more evident than in the timber industry, with the introduction of certification to ensure that timber and timber products are sourced from reliable and sustainable sources.

MKTS is constantly monitoring its suppliers to ensure it receives only certified timber from properly managed forests. All of its timber is certified through either the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification or Forest Stewardship Council schemes to ensure that

customers are provided with a quality certified product. With both schemes the verification system is certified by an independent third party, and MKTS has copies of its suppliers' certificates which it can make available for inspection if required.

In addition, MKTS's construction management have committed to the United Kingdom Timber Frame Association (UKTFA) training scheme: a comprehensive training scheme covering all aspects of timber frame construction and especially committed to health and safety.
