devoted to those who play a vital role in helping small enterprises with bright ideas to get successfully, and financially, off the ground; and the Low Carbon Vehicle areas dealing with both vehicles and infrastructure. The Jobs Zone will also make a welcome return to the show floor.”

Space for the twelfth show in the annual series is selling fast, with over 50% already reserved by exhibitors from home and overseas.
